Women who choose abortion sometimes need financial assistance because the cost of abortion varies widely as does insurance coverage of abortion. Resources are available to help women who are struggling to pay for abortion care.

Nationwide Resources

The **National Network of Abortion Funds (NNAF)** works to make sure that all women and girls can get the abortions they seek. If you are a woman looking for help paying for an abortion, NNAF is here to help you get what you need.
